SCHOOL CALENDAR

Entrevalles’s school year begins in January and ends in mid-October. It consists of 180 school days organized into four quarters and it observes local Guatemalan holidays and schedules recesses in Easter, mid-June, and early autumn.



GRADUATION REQUIREMENTS AND CURRICULUM

- Students follow a common core, university preparatory bilingual curriculum as mandated by the Guatemalan Ministry of Education.
- In 9th & 10th Grades students take an average of 13 courses per year.
- In 11th & 12th Grades students complete the two-year International Baccalaureate Programme in addition to local requirements.
- Each full year academic course passed earns 1 credit. IB courses in Grades 11th & 12th are weighted with an additional 0.5 credit.
- Spanish is the main language of instruction (80% of the academic courses are taught in Spanish).
